⁴⁹And behold, I am sending the promise of my Father upon you. But stay in the city until you are clothed with <u>power</u> from on high.

The life and soul of all our comforts lie treasured up in the promises of Christ. They are the breasts of all our consolation. [But] who knows not how powerless they are in the bare letter?



[The Holy Spirit]... reveals to the souls of sinners the good things of the covenant of grace, which the Father has provided, and the Son purchased... These things, I say, he effectually declares to the souls of believers; and makes them know them for their own good... This is [the Spirit's] work to the end of the world - to bring the promises of Christ to our minds and hearts, to give us the comfort of them, the joy and sweetness of them...

²⁵These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. ²⁶But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will <u>teach</u> you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.



Very many [Christians] have little taste and sweetness and relish in their souls of those truths which they savingly know and believe.



But when we are taught by [the Spirit], oh, how sweet is every thing we know of God! ...[The Spirit] teaches us of the love of God in Christ; he makes every gospel truth as wine well refined to our souls... When we find any of the good truths of the gospel come home to our souls with life, vigor, and power, giving us gladness of heart, transforming us... the Holy Ghost is then at work, pouring out his oil.
